Proposed Diversion of Public Footpaths, Curborough & Elmhurst No 11 & 12 and Public Footpath, Fradley & Streethay No 4

Lichfield District Council is in receipt of an application to divert parts of Public Footpaths, Curborough & Elmhurst No 11 & 12 and Public Footpath, Fradley & Streethay No 4 as shown on the attached plans. It is proposed to make three separate Orders as outlined below. This will allow each diversion to come into effect as the development proceeds rather than waiting until all elements are completed.

The first Order involves the stopping up of that part of Public Footpath, Curborough & Elmhurst No 11 shown by a solid black line (A-B-C) on the plan and diverting it onto the alignment shown by a broken black line (A-B-D) on the plan. The new route will have a width of 3 meters and have a tarmac surface.

The second Order involves the stopping up of that part of Public Footpath, Curborough & Elmhurst No 12 shown by a solid black line (**D-N-P-M**) on the plan and diverting it onto the alignment shown by a broken black line (**D-E-F-G-H-J-K-L-M**) on the plan. The new route will have a width of 3 meters and have a hoggin surface, with tarmac at road crossing points.

The third Order involves the stopping up of that part of Public Footpath, Fradley & Streethay No 4 shown by a solid black line (**R-S**) on the plan and diverting it onto the alignment shown by a broken black line (**R-S**) on the plan. The new route will have a width of 3 meters and have a hoggin surface.

The application for the proposed diversions is made in connection with planning applications 21/01859/REMM and 22/00040/REMM for the residential development off watery Lane, Curborough. Details of the planning application are available on the Council's website.

Before the Council makes a decision whether or not to make the requested Orders, I should like to take this opportunity to consult you and invite you to submit any indications of support or objection to the proposed diversions. Any such representations should be submitted no later than **1 April 2024.** If you propose to object to the Order, please advise the grounds upon which your objection is based.

Please note that we will not use your personal data for any purpose other than in connection with this application. It should however be noted that any consultation responses may ultimately be in the public domain as part of related statutory proceedings. Copies of objections and representations









including contact details may also be passed to the applicant for the Orders to enable them to enter into discussion with you and negotiate the withdrawal of any objections etc.
