

PEDESTRIANISATION TRIAL IN LICHFIELD CITY CENTRE



Consultation with members of the public and businesses has been on-going, by continuously assessing the trial's impact, we aim to enhance the scheme's effectiveness and contribute to creating a safe, prosperous, and vibrant city centre.

Following the initial six-month consultation period, these changes have been introduced immediately:

Monday to Wednesday - access permitted for blue badge holders, delivery drivers and permit holders.

Thursday to Sunday - all vehicles are restricted from travelling through the city centre.

Enforcement Once the new signs are installed robust management of the traffic restrictions will start, and fines will be issued where appropriate.

Consultation A new consultation period will begin so that all feedback from stakeholders can be recorded and formally considered. All stakeholders are encouraged to take part in the consultation process. A survey will be launched in December 2023, details will be shared as soon as possible.

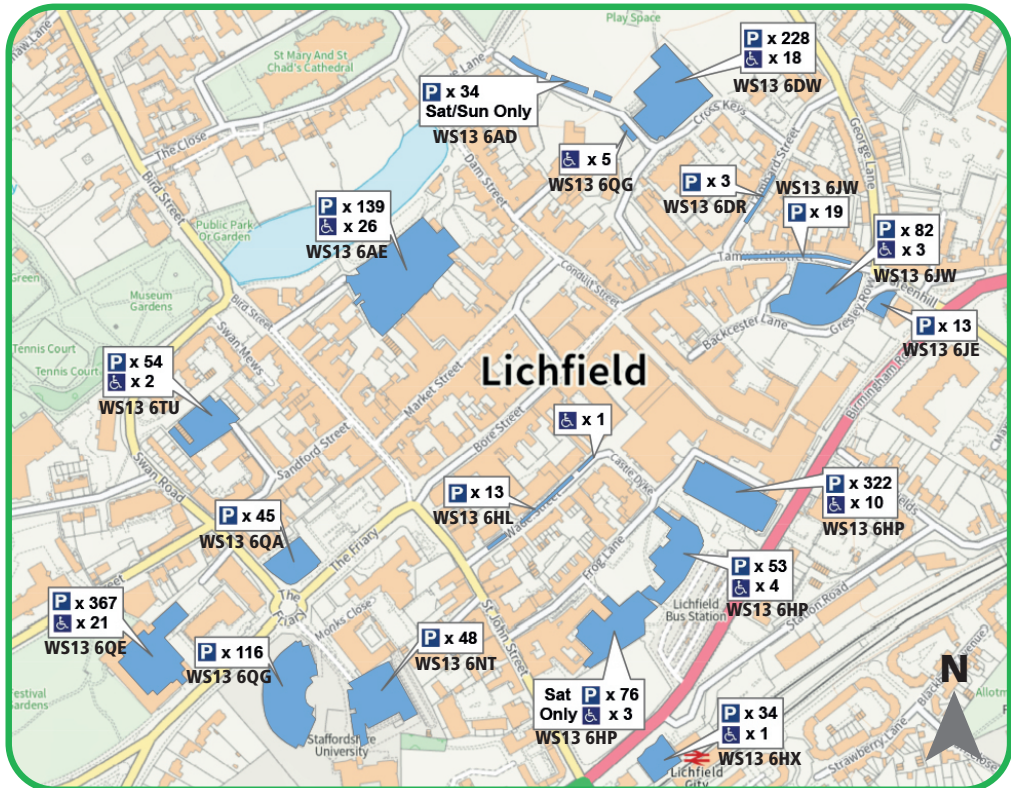
